-Parish Ponderings

This article is a follow on from our May article in which I briefly mentioned the Diocese of Bath and Wells challenge of addressing income shortfall post pandemic.

For some considerable time conversations have been ongoing about bridging a £2m income shortfall in providing ministry and clergy to every parish. The Diocese has made voluntary and involuntary redundancies. Some clergy have naturally retired while others have taken early retirement. Other cost cutting measures have also been actioned to ameliorate the severity of this financial impact. Despite this, more measures are required.

It is a necessity to reorganise ever larger groups of parishes (called benefices)

under a single clergy person in response to rural congregations shrinking. Parish churches are grouped together in benefices to work together and support each other. Groups of Benefices belong to a Deanery for the same purpose. Chew Magna is our deanery in which each clergy person may be responsible for between 4-7 churches according to proposals in the Deployment Plan for Stipendiary Clergy, version 2 which can be found at www.chew magna.org. Currently our Benefice of All Saints' Publow with Pensford, St Mary's Compton Dando and Chelwood village, (St Leonard's Church being officially closed) is covered by me as a part-time House for Duty priest. The Deployment Plan proposal does not recommend changing that this year, but as the Church communities are asked to submit their perspective on the whole plan by October, we also invite our village communities to submit their thoughts too so that we can include them in the feedback. The second part of the feedback that is wanted on the Deployment Plan, regards the possibility of our Benefice splitting up in future if there is no priest here. We're being asked to think now about which other Benefice our churches and villages might like to join. For example; it might be that All Saints' might wish to join Chew Valley East and St Mary's Compton Dando join with Keynsham because of close practical road links or other more traditional links. It is important that everyone is included in the conversations and consultation because things are changing and will change further. If you would like to speak to me, our churchwardens or PCC members, please do so. My email is dmcalverley@icloud.com. Our benefice email is pensfordparishoffice@gmail.com. St Mary's and Chelwood villagers are invited to take part in the first 30 minutes of our PCC meeting on July 27th 7:30pm on this topic. If you missed the July 11th All Saints' PCC discussions, you are also most welcome to join us too.




